ANOTHER PREMATURE MIRACLE

A newborn baby is called 'premature' if born at less than 37 weeks of pregnancy. When a premature baby is born, organs are also under-developed: including the brain, lungs, heart, kidneys etc, and hence, we have to support the functions of these organs in NICU till the time the baby can manage on his own.

This month also, **AWACH Newborn ICU (NICU)** had another opportunity of treating a miracle premature baby, born at **less than 7 months!**

Our baby could not breathe properly at birth, and required 'Non-invasive Positive Pressure Ventilation' for breathing support. Since the brain was immature, he often forgot to breathe, something called as 'Apnea of Prematurity', which is very dangerous. This was treated with injection Caffeine (Yes, the same component that is present in Coffee!). The kidneys were also so immature that a lot of Sodium (electrolyte) was lost through urine, leading to very low sodium level in blood- this had to be treated too. We carefully gave milk through a tube directly to the stomach, as premature babies cannot suck or drink directly. All steps were taken to ensure that there is no bleeding in the brain, which is common in these babies (intra ventricular hemorrhage). Each and every problem the baby had, was treated and managed in our NICU, and the baby was discharged successfully!

At AWACH NICU, we focus on providing the same comfort and care a baby would otherwise get inside the womb of a mother. This is called 'Developmentally Supportive Care'.

PEDIATRIC NEPHROLOGY OPD IN AWACH (നെഫ്രോളജി OPD)




THE BOON OF MOTHERHOOD **DELIVERY OF A HIGH RISK MOTHER IN AWACH**

During the early days of lockdown, a 31 year old lady visited AWACH with 8 weeks pregnancy. She had three previous pregnancy losses. In the first visit, she was found to have Hypertension (High BP) - tagging her as a High Risk Mother. She was started on anti-hypertensive drugs and pregnancy-supporting medicines. At 20 weeks, she was diagnosed to have Gestational Diabetes Mellitus. After initial dietary therapy, she was started on Insulin.

Pregnancy progressed successfully with a multi-disciplinary approach. She gave birth to a healthy female baby at 38+3 weeks gestation by normal delivery.

Hypertension and Diabetes are both nightmares to an Obstetrician. Both can cause a lot of pregnancy related complications like missed abortion, fetal growth restriction, eclampsia, intra-uterine fetal death, intrapartum complications etc. But if diagnosed in time and intervened judiciously, most of these complications can be prevented.

FIRST LAPAROSCOPIC PEDIATRIC SURGERY CONDUCTED IN AWACH!




Dr V Muthulingam Senior Pediatric Surgeon

The Department of Pediatric Surgery headed by Dr Muthulingam, conducted the first Laparoscopic Appendectomy (removal of diseased appendix) in AWACH in a 7 year old child. The child was successfully discharged after a very brief stay in hospital.

Ahalia Women & Children's Hospital is the only hospital in Palakkad with a Pediatric Surgery Department.

Laparoscopic surgeries have many advantages over open surgeries, including shorter hospital stay, less trauma, less pain, earlier return to school etc.




Our Pediatric Surgeon is an expert in the field of laparoscopic surgeries and even complicated thoracoscopic surgeries.
